2. Introduction

ARTCAM-384P2-THERMO is a thermal infrared camera, which adopts microbolometer and sensitive to FIR wavelength between $8\sim14\mu m$.

The resolution of this camera is 384 x 288 pixels.

Adopting USB2.0 interface, thus enables direct data transfer to PC without a capture board or a host adapter card.

Specially designed Viewer software ART-THERMO included, which makes it easier to acquire thermal images.

3. Main Features

•FIR (Far infrared) sensitivity

Adopting uncooled microbolometer as an infrared detector, sensitive to standard FIR wavelength (8 \sim 14 μ m).

High Resolution

Possible to output images with a resolution up to 384 x 288 pixels. The data (14 bits) obtained from the infrared detector can be transfer to a PC without compressing.

●USB2.0 Interface

Adopting USB2.0 interface, thus enables direct data transfer to PC without a capture board or a host adapter card.

NTSC Output (Option)

Adopting analog output terminal NTSC, so the image can be delivered to analog monitors directly.

Viewer software ART-THERMO is attached

Viewer Software ART-THERMO, which is designed especially for Thermal Infrared Cameras and compatible with Windows 7/8/10, is attached as standard.

Functions such as previewing, various settings, still/ moving image savings, graph creating and alarming are included.







■Please refer the restrictions below when you use ARTCAM.

(1) Recommended System Requirements

If the system specifications do not meet the requirements recommended above, it may be difficult to run at the maximum frame rate, especially at 48MHz high-speed mode.

(2) Connection of Multiple USB Devices

Please be aware that depending on the specifications of the user's PC, it may be difficult to supply the power to the USB devices when multiple USB devices are connected.

(3) USB2.0 cable Extension

We cannot guarantee the functionality of the USB2 camera if the user adopts USB2.0 extension cables or repeaters which are not confirmed by us. With the extension cables or repeaters, the bandwidth of transfer may differ, and thus caused malfunctions such as a low frame rate or recognition failure on the camera.

What may cause the problem is that the regulation of the power lines becomes not enough, and so causes impudence mismatch on data signals.
